- Development of creativity and increase in citizenship consciousness of children and the youth through participation in journalism
- Improvement of public speaking and literature
- Development of friendship and international cooperation

The venue:

Russia, The Republic of Karelia, Petrozavodsk

The dates of competition:

15 oktober 2018 - 29 november 2018

Organization of the Competition:

For the preparation and holding of the Competition, an organizing committee (hereinafter referred to as the Organizing Committee) (Appendix No. 1) was created from the leading teachers of the municipal educational institution Petrozavodsk Mily Balakirev children school of the Art's. Composition The Organizing Committee is approved by the head of the educational

institution. The Organizing Committee includes the following functions: develops and approves the program of the Competition, the composition of the Jury, carries out the preparation and conduct of the Competition, approves the list of participants and other events held within the framework of the Competition.

Conditions of participation:

The competition is attended by teenagers and young people of Russia, the CIS countries and foreign countries aged from 12 to 22 years.

The competition is held in one round.

Participants submit to the Organizing Committee of the competition an application form (Appendix No. 2) and creative writing in various media genres (review, correspondence, reportage, interview, article, essay and others) only in electronic form (Word format, Times New Roman font, 14, line spacing 1.5, standard fields) in Russian or English languages up to November 5, 2018 to e-mail: dshi.ptz@gmail.com

The nominations:

- A hero of the 21 century. Who is he?
- International cooperation in the North. Culture. People's diplomacy.
- Cinema. Part of nature in human life.
- Hot Arctic.
- The most unusual journey.

Age groups:

- 12-16
- 17-22

Criteria for evaluating the work:

Compliance with the topics of the competition, the depth of disclosure of topics, compliance with the chosen journalistic genre, style of presentation of the material, originality, literary literacy.

Contest materials are provided by one author (collective works are not accepted). The author has the right to send several materials in different nominations. Creative works are not reviewed and are not returned. Works that violate the copyrights of third parties (plagiarism, borrowed parts of the text, quoting without indicating the source, etc.) are not allowed to participate. Materials sent after November 5, 2018 will not be considered.

Competition Jury:

A jury consisting of professional journalists, editors of the media, representatives of Russian and foreign institutions is formed to evaluate the creative works of the participants of the Competition. The jury is approved by the Organizing Committee. The work of the jury is carried out remotely. Each member of the jury submits up to November 15, 2018 to the Organizing Committee a statement of the participants' work. The decision of the jury is final and not subject to revision.

Winner's reward ceremony:

According to the results of the Contest, the participants are awarded the titles of Laureate of I, II, III degree, in each nomination, as well as diploma winners (IV degree). Multiple participants can be nominated for each prize. The jury has the right to award not all diplomas of winners, and

also to appoint special diplomas and prizes. By decision of the jury the best works will be published.

The ceremony of summarizing the Contest will be held on November 29, 2018 in the city of Petrozavodsk (Republic of Karelia).

The diplomas of the laureates of the Competition who are not present at the awarding ceremony, as well as the diplomas of the participants will be sent in electronic form to the e-mail address indicated in the application. Distribution of award materials will be made from December 10 to December 30, 2018.

Organizational conditions of the competition:

Creative work, application form (to participant in competition and agreement to processing to process the data (*Appendix №3*)) must be sent till **05 november 2018** to e-mail: dshi.ptz@gmail.com
